3. How could the thesis be made more focused, risky, and clear in setting up the writer's analytical and synthesis points?
4. How could the analytical points more clearly compare and contrast the authors' values, assumptions, angles of vision, or rhetorical strategies in addressing the synthesis question? What further textual evidence could the writer add to develop these analytical points and make them more interesting or comprehensive?
5. How could the writer's synthesis points more clearly demonstrate the writer's thoughtful interaction with these texts? What examples or other specifics could the writer include to develop these synthesis points more effectively? How could the writer conclude this essay more effectively to leave readers with a new perspective on the texts and on the underlying question?
